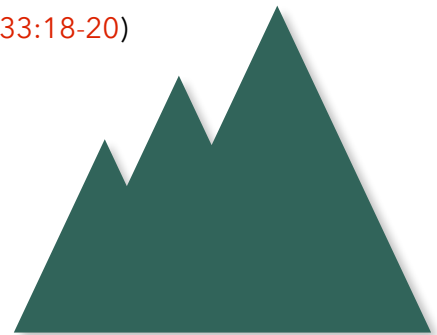




“Now I see” can only be experienced by those who are willing to make the journey.
