Scripture Reading: James 1:22-24



1 Corinthians 10:13 is a wonderful, reassuring passage. "No **temptation** has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is **faithful**, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of **escape**, that you may be able to endure it."

And yet, despite this God-breathed promise, there is sin that I can't overcome.

The Sin I Can't Overcome

- ► The sin I'm **hiding** (Psa 32:1-5; Psa 139:7-12)
- ▶ The sin I'm unwilling to **confess** (Psa 51:1-4; James 5:16)
- ▶ The sin I continue to **flirt** with (Prov 6:27-28)
- ▶ The sin I've grown **comfortable** with (Eph 4:17-19)
- ▶ The sin I rationalize (Isa 59:1-2)
- The sin I don't feel **sorry** about (2 Cor 7:10; Matt 3:8)
- The sin I will not **crucify** and leave behind (Gal 5:24; Heb 12:1-2)
- ▶ The sin I desire more than I desire **God**. (Matt 5:8; 2 Sam 12:13)
