### Psalm 119 is an amazing section of the Bible:

- It's the longest psalm, the Bible's longest chapter, and probably the most carefully structured.
- It has 22 stanzas, each with 8 verses. Within each stanza, the first word of each verse begins with the same letter. The psalm gradually works, stanza by stanza, through all 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet.

• It's all about God's revelation to mankind, which is why these words show up throughout its 176 verses: *law*, *testimonies*, *precepts*, *statutes*, *commandments*, *rules*, *word*.
