- The Tishbite, of Tishbe in Gilead, sent by God to announce "there shall be neither dew nor rain these \_\_\_\_\_\_" to King Ahab (17:1; 16:29-34; 18:2, 10, 13).
- 1 Kings 18: "After Many Days..."
- The "\_\_\_\_\_ of Israel" blamed God's prophet for his existing troubles (18:17-18)
- We need frequent, bold reminders that there's only \_\_\_\_\_ God (18:22-39; Acts 17:25)
  - A God who isn't \_\_\_\_\_ (Psa 8:3-4)
  - A God who isn't \_\_\_\_\_ in any way (Num 23:19)
  - A God who isn't \_\_\_\_\_ (Psa 139:7)
  - A God who \_\_\_\_\_ nothing from us (Psa 50:12)
- We must deliberately, fiercely keep ourselves from (18:40; 1 John 5:20-21)
