٠н	e was almost killed by his brothers (37:20), but instead (37:26-27)
٠Н	e was assumed by his father Jacob (37:33)
٠Н	e was sold in Egypt to Potiphar, the captain of Pharaoh's guard (39:1)
· TI	e most important thing about him: "The was Joseph" (39:2)
1	That didn't mean he was immune from the sins of others (50:20)
1	That didn't mean he had a shield from all temptation

• P	otiphar's wife "cast her eyes" on Joseph (39:6b-7)
,	The well-worn path to danger: "so when" (Gen 3:6)

• B	ut Joseph "" (39:8a). Why? How?
