But what does that big "C" word really mean?



This is why Jesus, the Son of God, told us what he did in Matthew 6:24:

"No one can serve two masters ... you cannot serve God and _____.

Your Bible is full of examples of people who made good choices and bad choices. One of the saddest examples is one of Jesus' own apostles in Matthew 26:14-16. Judas Iscariot was greedy—he wanted money so much, he was willing to betray Jesus.


