

In John 4:24, Jesus taught us some **REALLY** important things about God and how to worship him: "God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in ______ and _____."

Truth. If we're going to "offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe" (Heb 12:28), we have to listen to him. What does he want? What has he said true worship is?

Spirit. In Matthew 15:8-9, Jesus warned that I can "honor" God with my lips, but if my "heart is far from" him, my "worship" is "vain." My Father in heaven wants a real relationship with me. He wants to hear from me. How does that happen? Through **prayer**. What's prayer? It's talking from my heart to God. Can we even do that? Jesus taught us that we could. In Matthew 6:9, he told us to pray like this: "Our Father in heaven..."

Can you find 1 Timothy 2:1-2 in your Bible? Sometimes, we may not know what to pray for, but the apostle Paul gave us some great places to start:



Why do we pray? Jesus taught us to pray to "our Father in heaven" and God has promised us in his word, "The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working" (James 5:16).


TIMELINE Building Blocks:
