

**WORSHIP.** On Wednesdays this month we're looking at worship "then and now." Have you been working on memorizing Hebrews 12:28?

...and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe...

But the way people worshiped God in the Old Testament is very different from the way we worship today. Why? Why did things change? What's the difference between worship "then" and "now"?

In the Old Testament, we read about God's people being led and served by **priests**, starting with Aaron and his sons (Exo 28:1). In fact, an entire tribe of Israel, the tribe of Levi, was chosen by God to serve and guard this important work (Num 3:5-7).

The leader of all the priests was called the high priest. What would he do? Hebrews 5:1 tells us:

For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and \_\_\_\_\_\_

for sins. (Heb 5:1)


But there had to be many, many priests over the years "because they were prevented by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ from continuing in office" (Heb 7:23). Until... let's read about the greatest high priest of all in Hebrews 7:22-28.

Does that mean there aren't any priests today? No! Listen carefully to the way

the apostle Peter described **all** Christians in 1 Peter 2:9:

But you are a chosen race, a royal \_\_\_\_\_

holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.


#### **TIMELINE** Building Blocks:
