(Phil 1:9-II)

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours ______ Christ Jesus... (Phil 2:5)

Finally, my brothers, rejoice the Lord. (Phil 3:1)

Rejoice _____ the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. (Phil 4:4)

Or, as Paul wrote in 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, "______ always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we'll bear the fruit of JOY because we know God loves us.




