



- Peter—a “servant,” an “apostle,” and an “eyewitness” of the “\_\_\_\_\_” of Jesus—knows that the “putting off” of his body “will be soon.” How? “Our Lord Jesus Christ” had made it clear to him ([John 21:17-19](#)).
- “Therefore,” Peter writes this second letter “so that after my departure you may be able at any time to recall” ([1:15](#)) what it means to “\_\_\_\_\_” Jesus ([1:8](#)).
