
Early on in our study, we read about Jesus healing a man with an unclean spirit (Mark 1:21-28). We even heard the unclean spirit cry out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I _____ who you are—the Holy One of God" (1:24). But that unclean spirit was no match for Jesus in the

Capernaum synagogue.



In today's lesson, we follow Jesus and the apostles "to the other side of the _____, to the country of the Gerasenes" (Mark 5:1).

And when Jesus had stepped out of the boat, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an ______ spirit. (5:2)

This man had a terribly miserable life (5:3-5), but notice what he did as Jesus drew near.

And when he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and fell down before him. And crying out with a loud voice, he said, "What have you to do with me, Jesus, _____ of the Most High God? I adjure

you by God, do not _____ me." For he was saying to him, "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!" (5:6-8)

The unclean spirits end up in a herd of about 2,000 pigs while the demon-possessed man comes to be seated, clothed, and in his right mind (5:11-15).

Throughout the rest of Jesus's ministry, demons prove to be no match whatsoever.

•	What does the miracle in Matthew 15:21-28 reveal about Jesus?
•	Turning back to James 2, what big, <i>really</i> important point is James making in 2:14-26 when he talks about the demons believing and shuddering? What do we need to understand from this lesson?
