And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the ______ of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself." (Acts 2:38-39)

- Finally, what's the connection to us—and anyone today—according to what Peter and the apostles proclaimed in Acts 2:38-39?
